

## Instructor In Training

Position Description, Duties, & Responsibilities

Job Description: Instructor in Training

**Purpose of Position:** To train to become a PATH International Registered Instructor, as well as care for the LoveWay horses and complete other office duties as requested.

**Requirements**: Have a high school degree, must be 18 years old at the time of PATH Intl. certification, be a capable horseback rider, have extensive horse experience, be able to follow all LoveWay guidelines and PATH International guidelines. Training to become a Certified PATH Instructor will take a minimum of six months, but could take up to one year. LoveWay will pay the cost of PATH certification with the expectation the individual would stay a minimum of two years.

## **Key Responsibility Area:** Class Instruction

**Duties:** 

- 1. Follow supervisor's directions/comments when instructing a class.
- 2. Become PATH International member and start Instructor in Training Process.
- 3. Learn how to effectively manage volunteers in class and around the barn.
- 4. Learn to select appropriate tack for horses and riders depending on individual client needs.
- 5. Learn how to write rider evaluations with measurable goals.
- 6. Learn how to plan a lesson and judge the success of the lesson with measurable outcomes.

## **Key Responsibility Area:** Horse Care/Management

**Duties:** 

- 1. Properly feed, water, and care for horses when assigned.
- 2. School horses as requested under direction of Program Manager & Equine Manager.
- 3. Report any issues with horses to the Equine Manager as soon as possible.

## Key Responsibility: Office

Duties:

- 1. Assist with maintaining client records when requested.
- 2. Help maintain facility to PATH International Premier Accreditation Standards.
- 3. Assist with other office duties as requested.

**Reporting Requirement:** This position reports to the Lead Instructor. This is an hourly position that requires working a flexible schedule, with schedule determined by his/her supervisor. Position nonexempt and subject to overtime pay.
